Amid challenging economic times, especially in Europe, we are proud to communicate the results of our global recruiting outreach, which has proven to be effective for our MIAF candidates.

The unique program characteristics have resulted in more than (88%) of the students working after 3 months of graduation.



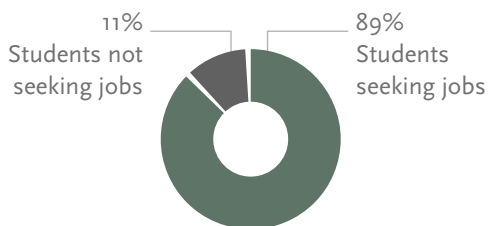
Regarding **Industries**, 85% of the students secured a job within the Financial sector, mainly in Corporate Finance (21%) and Retail & Commercial (21%) and also in the Public Sector and Financial Services/ Insurance. The rest of the students chose a career either in consulting (8%) or within the Industry (7%).

With regards to **regions**, the placements have been balanced between Europe (36%), Latin America (29%) and Asia (35%).

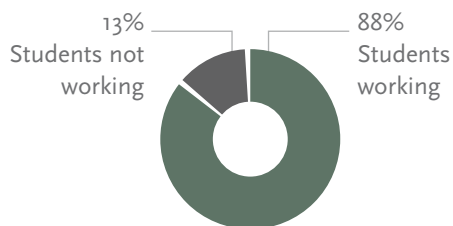
These new graduates joined the ranks of the more than 45,000 IE alumni who are based in more than 100 countries, both in public and private sectors and all types of industries.

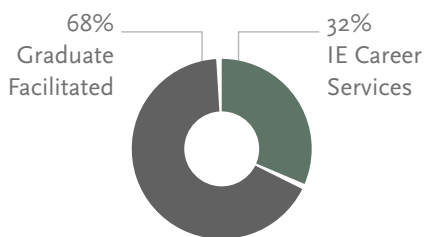
Job seekers



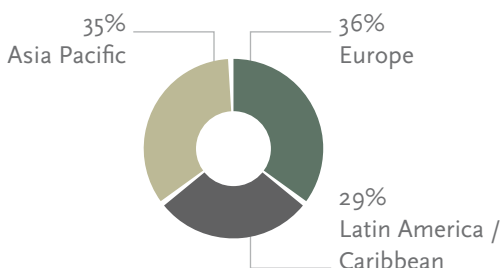
Situation 3 months after graduation



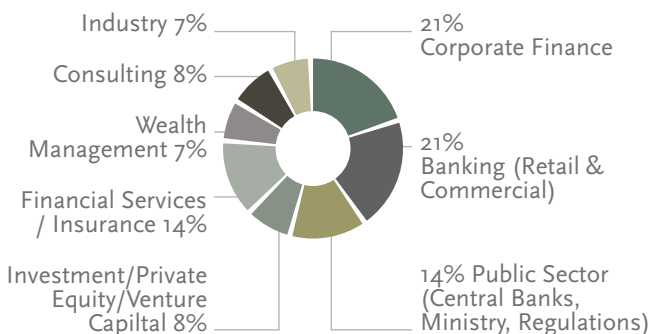
Source of job offer
