COMMITMENT DOCUMENT FOR IE SCHOLARSHIPS

Dear candidate.

It is a great privilege for the IE Foundation -on behalf of its many donors and benefactors- to benefit students with an IE scholarship and we trust that this grant could help you meet the financial commitment required to study at IE. To fully appreciate the importance of the scholarship in case you are granted one, we would like to explain how we are able to provide grants and what we expect of you as an IE Scholar if you are granted an IE scholarship. Please read this document carefully to understand the terms and conditions of IE scholarships.

IE scholarships are funded by the several types of donors of the IE Foundation and IE in general. We hope that you will recognize that their help and their trust make grants possible. The IE Foundation offers scholarships as an investment in our student's education and future professional success. Our belief is that, once you graduate, you will be able to make a meaningful and positive impact on your family, organization, and the community where you live and work.

All Institutional Scholarships provided by the IE Foundation are funded by alumni and corporate donations. That means that by accepting the scholarship terms and conditions, you morally commit to contribute to future funds that will be used to help other high potential IE students access to top education that will help them to go and make important contributions to society.

As an IE student and future Alumn, you represent one of many ambassadors that make up the IE community. We firmly believe that recipients of these scholarship funds also assume certain responsibility with regard to the stewardship of scholarship donations to support future students at IE. We anticipate that you will add to the distinction of the IE community in constructive and responsible ways while a student and then as a graduate as well. By accepting an Institutional scholarship, you are agreeing to comply with the following guidelines and expectations:

- 1. Participating in campus life is an enriching endeavor; becoming a contributing citizen in the IE community is even more fulfilling. As an IE Scholar, you have the responsibility of exemplifying good citizenship. We expect you to abide by the Code of Ethics.
- 2. Maintain the minimum academic standards determined by your scholarship.
- 3. Try to attend at least two IE events annually

Terms and Conditions Fellow SCHOLARSHIP

Apart from the mention above if you hold a Fellow Scholarship you also have the following terms and conditions: The expectation is that an IE Fellow will embody the work ethic, intelligence, sensitivity and enthusiasm that are characteristic of our student body.

Fellow Scholarship will take place over the time your program takes place. Up to 5 hours per week on average.

The Financial Aid and Student Service Department has high expectations of its Fellows and we expect you to be an ambassador of the school during the program and upon graduation, demonstrating professionalism and excellence as an IE alumni. It is our commitment to you to award this fellowship and the same commitment is requested of you in fulfilling it.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual undertakings of the IE Fellow Award accepted, IE University and the Recipient agree as follows:

- 1. Confidentiality. The information included in the documents relating to the fellowship is confidential to both parties.
- 2. Non-Disclosure. The Recipient agrees not to use the Confidential Information obtained through the fellowship in any way, except for the purpose set forth above.
- 3. Protection of Secrecy. The Recipient agrees to take all steps reasonably necessary to protect the secrecy of the Confidential Information, and to prevent the Confidential Information from falling into the public domain or into the possession of unauthorized persons.
- 4. Non-Completion. Students who do not complete their fellowship responsibilities will see their award cancelled.
